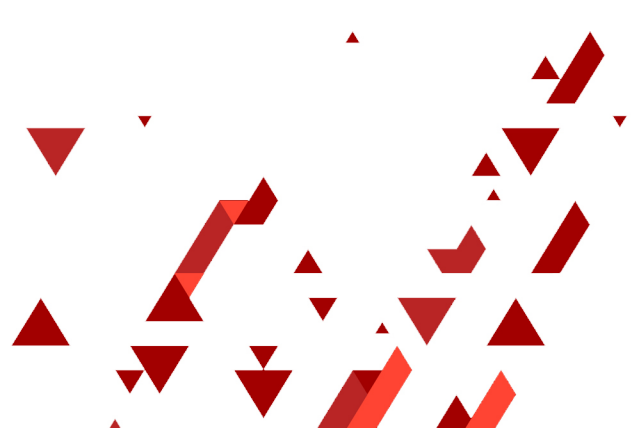




# INSIGHTS

**Semifinal COPPA ITALIA FRECCIAROSSA 2021-22**

AC Milan have progressed or won the trophy in five of their eight Coppa Italia meetings with Inter in the knockout stages - however, Inter have won five of their last eight matches against the Rossoneri in the competition (D1 L2), including the last one (January 26th, 2021), 2-1 via a Christian Eriksen free-kick goal in the 97th minute (after Lukaku and Ibrahimovic strikes).

Inter have found the net in each of their last nine meetings with AC Milan in all competitions (they last enjoyed a longer run in November 1997, 12 in a row), winning six of these games (D1 L2).

AC Milan are unbeaten in seven of their last eight matches against Inter across the Coppa Italia, Champions League and Italian Super Cup (W4 D3): indeed, AC Milan's loss percentage against the Nerazzurri is 38% in Serie A but drops to 27% in cup games.

AC Milan have drawn 11 of their 17 Coppa Italia Semi Finals first legs – they have won only two of those matches (L4): 2-1 against Inter on June 23rd, 1985, and 1-0 against Alessandria on January 26th, 2016, thanks to a Mario Balotelli goal.

Inter have been eliminated in each of their last four Coppa Italia Semi Finals, after progressing from each of the previous six: Inter have lost the most matches at this stage of the competition (19).

AC Milan have kept a clean sheet in 11 of their last 17 Coppa Italia games, with no side registering more since the 2017/18 campaign (11 also for Juventus).

Inter's last eight Coppa Italia goals have been scored by seven different players; Alexis Sánchez is the only player to have scored two in that time.

Rafael Leão and Olivier Giroud are the two Serie A players with the most goals scored at a single Stadium in all competitions in 2022: six goals each at the Meazza.

Alexis Sánchez is the only Serie A player to have scored in four different competitions this season: he has found the net in his last two Coppa Italia appearances while no Inter player has scored in three in a row in the last eight campaigns.

Ivan Perisic has been involved in seven goals against AC Milan for Inter (two goals, five assists), against no other side has he managed more in all competitions (also seven against Chievo and Fiorentina).

Among the sides to have faced Juventus more than twice in the Coppa Italia, Fiorentina have the highest winning percentage against them (43% - 6/14); however, the Viola have won only one of their last six meetings against the Bianconeri in the competition (D3 L2), 2-1 thanks to a Mohamed Salah brace on March 5th, 2015 (Fernando Llorente scored for Juventus).

Juventus have won 11 of their last 15 matches against Fiorentina in all competitions (D2 L2), however they have won only two of the last five (D2 L1).

Since 2010, Juventus have kept a clean sheet in nine away matches against Fiorentina in all competitions: against no other side have they managed more in this time - however, 11 of their last 22 such matches ended in a draw (nine wins and two defeats for Juventus).

Fiorentina have scored 36 goals in 14 home games this season, 2.6 per game on average; only Inter (40) and Lazio (37) have registered more at home among Serie A 21/22 teams across all competitions.

Juventus have appeared in the Coppa Italia Semi Finals the most often (33 times); furthermore, they have progressed to the Final of the competition the most times (20), followed by AS Roma (16).

Fiorentina have been eliminated in three of their four Coppa Italia Semi Finals since 2010 (they progressed from the 2013/14 Semi Final, against Udinese), after having progressed from the previous three in the competition.

Juventus have mustered the most Coppa Italia shots in 2022: 47, at least 10 more than any other side in the same period.

Krzysztof Piatek has scored 12 goals in nine Coppa Italia appearances, more than any other player since his debut in the competition in 2018/19.

Juan Cuadrado scored 26 goals in 106 matches for Fiorentina between 2012 and 2015 – he has delivered two assists this season in all competitions (both in his last three games, against Empoli and Torino): since 2012/13 he has assisted at least four goals in each season (17 in 2021/22).

Dusan Vlahovic could become the third player in the big five European Leagues to score for and against a single team in all competitions this season, after Dodi Lukébakio (Wolfsburg) and Gaëtan Laborde (Montpellier).
